

Revolutionary Gospel

Matthew 28:16-20, ¹⁶ Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. ¹⁷ And when they saw him they worshiped him, but some doubted. ¹⁸ And Jesus came and said to them, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. ¹⁹ Go there-fore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age.”

Key Idea: The gospel revolutionizes our lives by giving us a new beginning, a new purpose, and a new promise that will result the transformation of the world.

The gospel is revolutionary because it...

1. provides a new beginning.
2. presents a new king and risen Savior.
3. proclaims a new authority.
4. produces a new command.
5. pronounces a new sign of commitment.
6. prescribes a new way of life.
7. promises a new relationship.
