## Holy, Holy, Holy

## Ephesians 6:14b; Philippians 3:3-14

To put on the breastplate of righteousness is to...

## 1. <u>exclude</u> any reliance on my self-righteousness.

**Ephesians 4:24** | <sup>24</sup> ...put on the new self, created after the likeness of God in true righteousness and holiness.

**Ephesians 5:8-9** | for at one time you were darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Walk as children of light <sup>9</sup> (for the fruit of light is found in all that is good and right and true),

**Philippians 3:3-8a** | <sup>3</sup> For we are the circumcision, who worship by the Spirit of God and glory in Christ Jesus and put no confidence in the flesh— <sup>4</sup> though I myself have reason for confidence in the flesh also. If anyone else thinks he has reason for confidence in the flesh, I have more: <sup>5</sup> circumcised on the eighth day, of the people of Israel, of the tribe of Benjamin, a Hebrew of Hebrews; as to the law, a Pharisee; <sup>6</sup> as to zeal, a persecutor of the church; as to righteousness under the law, blameless. <sup>7</sup> But whatever gain I had, I counted as loss for the sake of Christ. <sup>8</sup> Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord…

# 2. <u>embrace</u> the foundation of Christ's righteousness.

**Philippians 3:8b-9** | <sup>8b</sup> For his sake I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ <sup>9</sup> and be found in him, not having a right-eousness of my own that comes from the law, but that which comes through faith in Christ, the righteousness from God that depends on faith—

#### 3. engage the pursuit of personal holiness.

**Philippians 3:12-14** | <sup>12</sup> Not that I have already obtained this or am already perfect, but I press on to make it my own, because Christ Jesus has made me his own. <sup>13</sup> Brothers, I do not consider that I have made it my own. But one thing I

do: forgetting what lies behind and straining forward to what lies ahead, <sup>14</sup> I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.
